

## Grading system of the Institution

### I FAENZA 01

ISIA adopts the ECTS GRADING AND ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

The Italian University grading system is based upon a scale of thirty marks: 18 is the minimum mark to pass successfully an exam, 30 is the highest mark, and a "cum Laude" merit may also be added; this is awarded when the test is considered exceptional. The ECTS grading system on the other hand, may be based upon a scale of six levels, illustrated according to performance grades.

The differentiation of marks is obtained through a statistical analysis of the frequency of grades in the traditional system; the ISIA of Faenza has elaborated the following differentiation table:

<i>ECTS Grade</i>	<i>Description</i>	<i>ISIA corresponding grades</i>
<b>A</b>	excellent test result totally fulfilling the requirements	<b>30 + merit</b>
<b>B</b>	very good test result with personal re-elaboration and very few errors	<b>30</b>
<b>C</b>	good test result, with a few errors	<b>27 – 29</b>
<b>D</b>	satisfactory test result with considerable errors	<b>24 – 26</b>
<b>E</b>	satisfactory test result that only fulfils the minimum requirements	<b>18 – 23</b>
<b>F</b>	unsatisfactory test result, with totally inadequate preparation	<b>≤17</b>
